Create some garden art!

Materials

- Fresh flowers and leaves.
- Rolling pin.
- White fabric/Old sheets/Thin paper/Old pillow cases.

Make sure an adult is joining in! You could use the instructions to become the teacher.

- 1. Safely cut the flowers from the stems, leaving a little bit of stem attached.
- 2. As a practise; Using a rolling pin or rubber mallet, find a workspace that you can use them safely. Use the rolling pin and roll over the flowers onto the fabric or paper. Does the colour come off?
- 3. Choose your piece of fabric and lay the flowers out onto the fabric creating a design. Then lay a piece of paper over the top to roll your rolling pin over.
- 4. Take the piece of paper off and see if your design looks how you imagined it! If not, you could add some more flowers or use crayons to help bring out the colours.

Challenge

If you don't have a rolling pin, use some paints and different flowers/leaves to create a picture from the different textures.
