1	Locational Knowledge	I am learning to use a map of the world to locate and name key features.	I know how to locate and name the continents and oceans of the world.	What are the names of the world's oceans and continents? Show the children a coloured world map. What can they tell you about it? Allow time for feedback. Work through the continent powerpoint and watch the first video. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wYYakyS HOg (Continents) Children complete labelling the continents on a map (label continents & oceans). Teach the children the continent song to help them remember the names of the continents. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=K6DSMZ8b3LE (Continent song). Work through the oceans powerpoint and watch the first video. Children complete labelling the oceans on a map. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1WZsxVDTqcU (Oceans). Teach the children the ocean song to remember the names of the oceans. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X6BE4VCYnqQ (Ocean Song). Children to complete the world map puzzle 1 to bring their learning together.

Chdn to label a map of the UK. Why is the UK an island? What seas surround the UK? Chdn to name the seas around the coast of the UK: Atlantic Ocean, North Sea, Irish Sea, English Channel. What are the human and physical features of the UK? (Atlas) Recap on what human and physical features are from Y1. Can the children give examples of either? Explain that they are going to plot the location of

Produce a class map with it annotated with the features for class display. Where in the world is China? Explain that the children are going to learn about China. What do they know already? Take feedback. Watch the short video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=q7JK5Vxf VQ. Look at world map and ask Chdn where is China? Which continent is it in? Which oceans is it near?

(Key facts provided) Write a conclusion about what they found. Chn to research other similarities and differences between UK and China. How is the culture in China different to England? (1 laptop per sm grp) Start with the opening quiz on the Powerpoint (Culture). What is meant by the word culture? Allow time for feedback. Share the definition. What is your culture? Do we all have the same culture in Nottingham? Why? Children complete comparing cultures representing their culture. Work through

Complete the In China column which represents what the children have learnt about the culture of China. Sm grps given the task of researching an area of Chinese culture to feedback to the class so they can complete their table. Using the table, children compare the sections to identify similarities and differences between the 2. Share what they have discovered. How does a school day in China compare to ours? (2 lessons) What is a day in our school like? Allow time for discussion and feedback. Do they think this is the same in China? Why? Explain that they are going to compare school life in England and China. Watch the video and complete the timetable for the day in China. Work through the questions allowing time for feedback. Complete comparison table. Watch the link. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZE-TQKhOdWk (A short video of a child in Shanghai). How is this experience different / similar to that of Hogarth? Using the writing frame, children to write a letter to a child in China which tells them all about attending Hogarth and how it is different / similar to China and what they most like/dislike about schools in China.
