

Art Unit Plan- Year 1 -Spring 1 (Buildings)

Year 1 Spr 1	Concept	Subject Skill (Learning Objective)	Subject Knowledge	Pedagogical Content (how you will teach)
Day 1	Developing ideas Critical study & understanding of art	I am learning to begin to record simple media explorations in my sketchbook I am learning to express an opinion on the work of a famous artist I am learning to cut, tear and scrunch materials to create a collage	I am learning to say what I like and dislike about Paul Klee's 'Castle and Sun' I am learning to cut, tear and arrange materials to create a collage picture of a castle	<p>KQ: What is a collage?</p> <p>Show children the focus artwork 'Castle and Sun' by Paul Klee. <i>What type of art is this?</i> Explain that it is a painting and that we are going to create our own collage versions. <i>What is a collage? How is a collage made?</i></p> <p><i>What can you see in the picture? What shapes can you see? What colours? How has the artist created a castle? Can you see the castle? Can you see the sun? What do you like? What do you dislike?</i> Discuss the artwork with the children using the 'Let's Talk Art' resource.</p> <p>Children to use the artist evaluation sheet to evaluate the artwork.</p> <p>Plenary: <i>What did you like? What did you dislike?</i></p> <p>KQ: How do you make a collage?</p> <p><i>How is a collage made?</i> Discuss with the children how collages are made using lots of different materials, which are put together to create a picture. To do this, we will need to cut, tear and stick different materials. Look at the shape mats and discuss with children that these are the shapes we might use to create our castles. Referring back to the focus artwork, discuss which shapes could be used for different parts of the castle. Model cutting and tearing these shapes out of different papers. Children to practise cutting shapes (use the shape mats to support) and arranging them to form a part of a castle.</p> <p>Plenary: <i>What went well? What did you find difficult?</i></p>
Day 2	Collage	I am learning to cut, tear and scrunch materials to create a collage I am learning to sort and arrange materials to create simple pictures	I am learning to cut, tear and arrange materials to create a collage picture of a castle	<p>KQ: Can you make a castle collage?</p> <p>Revisit the focus artwork. <i>How has the artist made it look like a castle? What shapes have they used? Can you design a castle?</i></p> <p>Model drawing a castle, talking about the different shapes you could use to create the different parts of the castle. Children to draw the outline of a castle. (Castle outlines and photo packs included in resources folder)</p> <p>Next model cutting, tearing and sticking shapes of different coloured paper and tissue paper to layer on to your collage. (Have shape mat on the table to help).</p> <p>Children to create their castle collages.</p> <p>Plenary- <i>What went well? What did you find difficult?</i></p>
Day 3	Critical study & understanding of art	I am learning to talk about my own work, describing how I feel about it	I am learning to evaluate my collage	<p>KQ: How do you feel about your collage?</p> <p>Look back at completed collages from yesterday. <i>What went well? What did you find difficult? How do you feel about your work?</i></p> <p>Children to evaluate their own collage using the evaluation sheet.</p>
