We will be learning this term ...

We will be continuing our Read Write Inc. phonics lessons, focussing on blending and segmenting in order to read fluently, to prepare for the Year 1 phonics screen in June. In English we have been working hard to improve the quality and quantity of our writing and we will continue to do this in summer 1. The children have been working more independently during their speed write lessons, focussing on a specific picture to use their creative writing skills. In maths we will be moving on to learning about multiplication and division and continuing working on our arithmetic skills. Our CSI focus this half term is history, we will be learning all about Robin Hood and the Sheriff of Nottingham. As part of our history topic we will be going to Sherwood Forest to find out about the Legend of Robin Hood.
