## We will be learning this term...

“Hogarth at Night” will be our theme this half term, exploring animal encounters throughout our learning. In Science, we will look at living things and their habitats; learn to identify a range of habitats, explain a simple food chain, ask simple scientific questions, and investigate.

In Book-talk, we will explore the sweet and endearing storybook Owl Babies by Martin Waddell. We will use our Paw-some readers to help us retrieve, predict, sequence and discuss vocabulary. We will continue our English groups, ensuring our phonics knowledge is applied and expanding and improving our writing quality.

In Maths, we will be continuing to explore two-digit numbers. We will be building our Tens and Ones toolkit to solve problems involving addition and subtraction. Later this term, we have geometry focus learning properties of 3D shapes.

As well as exploring collage in our Art and textiles in our Design and Technology sessions, we will be creating media in Computing. The children will learn to apply skills to capture and explore digital photographs.
