				What does this timeline have on it that can help us to put events in order?     Explain to the children that timelines are to show the movement of time. This is then their task for the their books.     Lesson 2   What does 10 years look like on a timeline?     Show children the following picture. When do we think these devices are from? How do you know? If we could guess a year, what year do you think these phones were around? Explain to children that even though 10 years might looks quite small on a timeline (you can use the classroom timeline to help you demonstrate this), it is actually quite a long time.
				Show children the following events/dates and they will have to put these in order with their partner (no bookwork today).     Lesson 3 How do we make sure that events are in order?     Image: Show children the picture to the left that reminds them of what they were doing on the previous day. What can you remember from sequencing the photos from the previous day? Was this towards the end of the timeline or at the beginning.     Show children the same pictures from the previous day but explain that they will be putting them in order on a timeline today. Children to complete their timeline.
