we will be learning this term ...

Our topic for this half term is 'The Vikings' Our focus texts will be Traitor by David Hingley. In English, we be learning how to write a story portraying the role of the main character. We will be focussing on varying our sentence structure and using similes and metaphors to create imagery. Later in the term, we will also be writing a diary based on a Viking. In maths, we will be learning about multiplication nd division using the formal written methods before moving on to fractions. In art, we will be looking at the work of various artists use collage in their work for our buildings and landscapes unit. We will then use this inspiration to complete our own collage based on lindisfarne (the first thing the Viking people and we will be learning to compare the lives of both rich and poor people during that time period. Finally, in design and technology, we will be learning all about structures and how to join and combine materials and components in a variety of ways including temporary and permanent methods to create our own Viking lookout tower.
