We will be learning this term...

In CSI this half-term, we will be transforming into 'time travelers' and journeying back to Ancient Mexico! Our adventure will kick off with an exciting Mexico-themed day, immersing ourselves in the rich and vibrant Mexican culture. History will be our primary focus, as we delve into key historical events and develop a chronological understanding of this fascinating period.

In Science, we'll be studying the human body, focusing on teeth and the digestive system. We'll explore the different types of teeth and learn about the organs that make up our digestive system.
