CREATIVE

Help your child draw the shape of an egg on a plain piece of paper. If you like, you can also help your child cut out the shape. Using crayons, markers, or paint, let your child decorate the egg. Can you paint patterns on egg shapes? Can you print a chick using circular objects? Make a hand print chick or paper plate chick with folded legs.

Learn Nursery rhymes and songs, such as Hickerty Pickerty my black hen, Chuck, chuck, Good morning Mrs Hen, Encourage your child to fill in the missing rhyming words. Can they write them? Can you think of words that rhyme with hen or fox and write them?

Your child could try reading these High Frequency words by matching them, play hiding them around the house, garden and finding them. Write them in sand, paint, chalks or paper. **I can play with the big to went** Try putting them into sentence and have a go at writing them.



NUMERACY

Act out the story; One person the hen, the other the fox. The hen tells the fox where they are going using prepositions EG: around, over, under, in, out, in front, behind, up, down. Use an old egg box to make into individual chicks; how many objects can you fit into one chick? Can you make a cake and weigh the ingredients? Which is the heaviest? Lightest? Find something heavier than a book, lighter than a book etc
